- 86/17 CHAIRMAN It was proposed, seconded and unanimously agreed that Councillor L.E. Harris be Chairman of the Committee.
- 87/17 ROYAL BRITISH LEGION REMEMBRANCE DAY PARADE The Chairman opened the meeting and then suspended the meeting to enable the members of the British Legion to discuss the issues concerned. A full discussion took place and the Chairman then re-convened the meeting and Members who needed to declare an interest did so. The Committee then **RESOLVED** to accept the Town Clerk's report on the way forward as discussed with the British Legion and to agree the sum of £1,000 which will be available to the Remembrance Parade Committee as required. It was also agreed that the following four Council Members be appointed to that Committee: Councillors Ms K.V. Crisell, A.H. Davis, M. Kangarani and Ms C.L. Rackham.

(Councillor F.T. Morris declared a pecuniary interest in the above item as he is a member of the RBL).
(Councillor N.S. Penman declared a pecuniary interest in the above item as he is a member of the Totton branch of the RBL).
- 88/17 PARKING BY OAKFIELD SCHOOL ON COUNCIL LAND The Sub Committee in great detail discussed the two options available from the Town Clerk's report having received legal advice. The Town Clerk advised that if the Council wished the school to continue to use the parking the only safe option would be option 2 to re-appropriate the land. A proposal to adopt option 1 was made but not seconded and then it was proposed by Councillor A.H. Davis and seconded by Councillor Ms K. Lord that subject to a letter being sent to the school explaining the proposed Council's action option 2 be adopted to re-appropriate the land and the Town Clerk to

instigate the necessary procedures as soon as possible to ensure the Council meet the legal requirements. RESOLVED that the above proposal be adopted.
